Market Information and Requirements:

- **COST**: <u>Vending is FREE</u>! Tomaquag does not charge vendors to set up at our events.
- **SPACE:** This property is a large outdoor field. Places for registered vendors will be assigned. For this event you will need to provide your own table and canopy (if desired; recommended in case of rain).
- **TIME**: Set up time starts at 10:00am on the day of the event, and you must be completely set up no later than 11:30 am for the start of the event. There is no advanced setup. Tomaquag cannot be held responsible for property left on the premises. We request that all vendor booths remain open until 4:00pm.
- **PARKING**: Parking is available.
- **FEATURES**: Vendors are responsible for leaving the vendor area in the condition that it was originally received, i.e. removal of all debris such as boxes and trash.
- **REQUIREMENT**: In keeping with the Indigenous Arts and Crafts Law (1990), Indigenous artists must have tribal affiliation on file at Tomaquag Museum. Tomaquag Museum is making every effort to adhere to the Indigenous Arts and Crafts Act (IACA of 1990). We advertise our events as Indigenous arts markets and in order to be in compliance with federal law, we have to confirm eligibility for all of our vendors. You will notice the vendor registration form requests the necessary documentation for this purpose. If you haven't already done so, please include the required documentation along with your vendor registration. Once you have submitted this paperwork, you are all set for all future programming. You may send it via email, mail or drop your paperwork off to the administrative office at Tomaquag Museum.
